One of these sources needs to be a McKenna online database subscription. Sources other than the Internet which may be helpful are: books, magazines, brochures, pamphlets, travel agencies or maps. Make sure you give me the title, author, publisher, and date of publication. If you do go on the Internet (with your parent's permission), please give me the full website address.
